Pillows made with polyurethane and latex foam cores. Mattress or pillow covers are made with cotton, polyester, viscose fabrics and their blends, raw or dyed. Including accessories such as: Sewing threads made of recycled polyester (recycled content 100 %: from post-consumer PET bottles or pre-consumer yarn), zippers, embroidered labels. height max. tested: 20 cm. Partly produced by using material certified according to OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100.


